approximately 3 hours by car



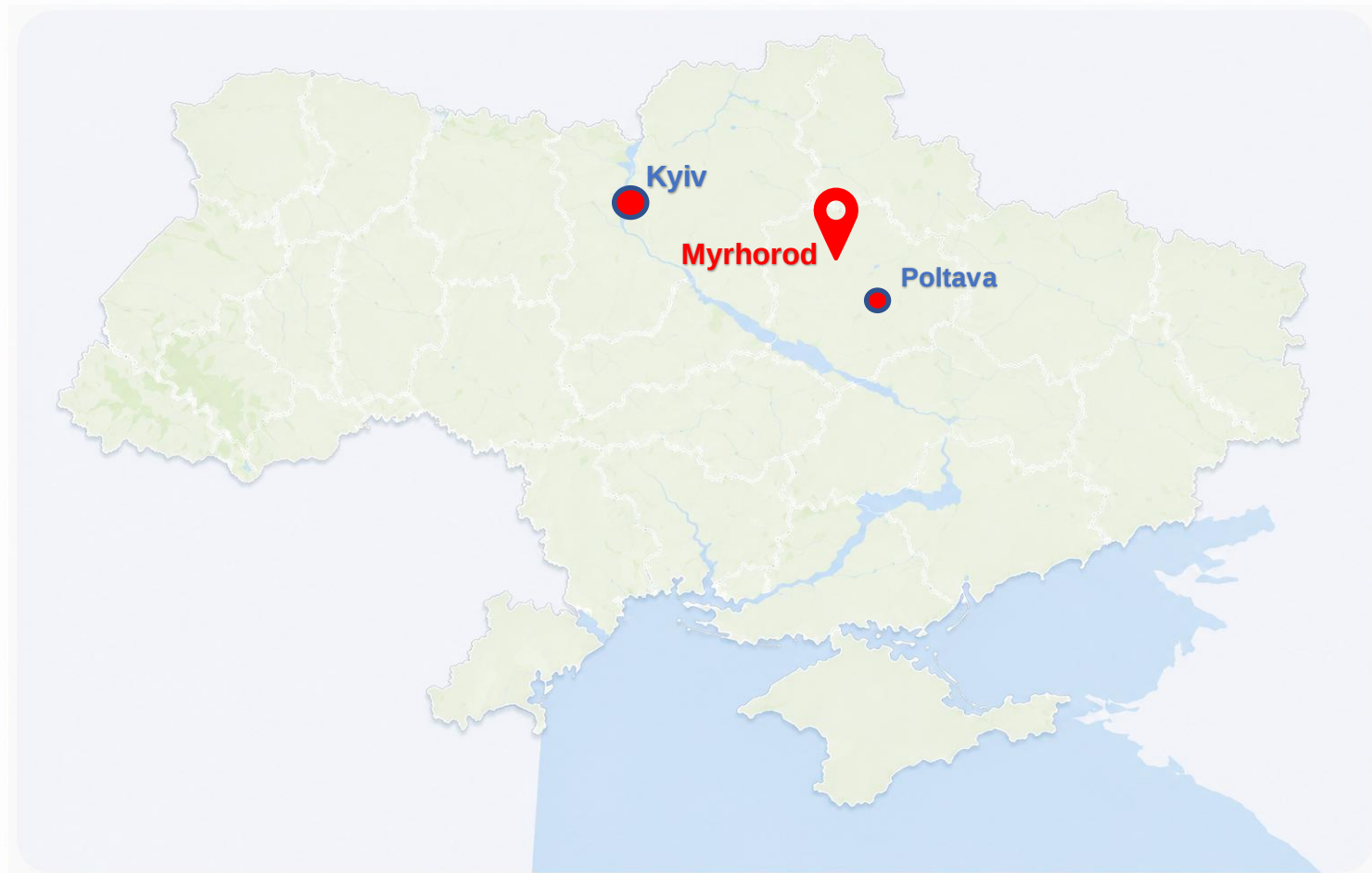
Population coverage of several regions
